WHAT IS AVID JEOPARDY?



Contest Purpose

Questioning is a huge art of learning; can you train yourselves to answer in the form of a question? Test your team's knowledge on various topics related to the AVID Curriculum and program in AVID Jeopardy.

Procedure

Teams consisting of four to six (4-6) members each will compete by giving appropriate responses to items presented by a moderator. These items may be in the form of questions. Winners will be determined by a series of elimination rounds.

- A. This competition will take place during the conference on April 22, 2024.
- B. Teams must register by April 8, 2024.
- C. AVID Jeopardy will be played using Kahoot. One member of each team will need to have a device logged into the Kahoot game.
- D. AVID schools will be limited to two teams per school. Additional teams will be put on a waiting list.
- E. There will be up to 9 teams competing in rounds 1 & 2 (18 total teams). Competition times will be updated after each round. If a team does not check in to compete for their scheduled competition time, they automatically forfeit.
- F. Each round will contain an equal number of questions. Questions will NOT be shared prior to the contest.
- G. The number of rounds will be determined based on the number of teams in the competition.
- H. The two highest scoring teams for each round will advance to the final round.

Competition Guidelines

- This competition will take place on April 22, 2024. AVID
 Jeopardy will be played using Kahoot. One member of
 each team will need to have a device logged into the
 Kahoot game.
- There will be up to 9 teams competing in rounds 1 & 2
 (18 total teams). Competition times will be sent to each
 team in advance. If a team does not check in to
 compete when their name is posted, they automatically
 forfeit.
- The AVID Jeopardy event is open to the public (and other teams) to watch throughout the morning. Your team is allowed to show up only during your scheduled competition time.
- 4. Only the first answer given by a team is to be judged. Different questions will be asked during each matchup. The team that has the highest number of points after clearing the Jeopardy board will be declared the winner of that match. The points will be tallied by the judges and displayed throughout the competition.
- 5. In the event of a tie score, Final Jeopardy will be used waging point totals.

- Audience members may observe the competition.
 Communication between observers and team members or observers during the competition will not be allowed.
- 7. The moderator and judges will be furnished with a copy of the questions and answers. Judges make all rulings. The moderator will respond to the competitors' answers by saying correct or incorrect. Only judges are allowed to challenge answers. (Competitors may not challenge any answer during the event process.)

Final Round:

Questions will continue to be asked as in the previous rounds. In the event of a tie score, Final Jeopardy will be used waging point totals.

Point totals will used in the competition rounds.
